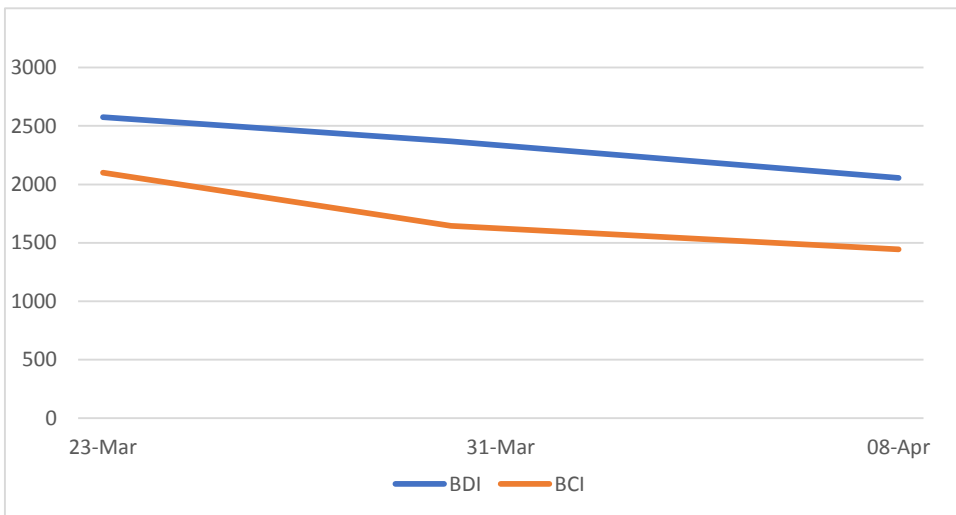
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## Market insights UPDATE WEEK 14

- Shanghai lockdown escalation adds to supply chain chaos
- Greek-owned fleet reaches record in dry-bulk sector and gas carriers
- TOTALENERGIES, to stop funding Arctic LNG-2 project and halt purchases from Russia.
- EXMAR's FSRU was taken from the Netherlands on 5-year charter.
- THE WHITE HOUSE, unounced on March 25th to provide EU with 15BN m3 of LNG in 2022.
- SHELL signs MoU with German LNG terminal in Brunsbuttel.
- ITALY is looking to procure 2 FSRUs authorising SNAM to negotiate acquiring one and lease the second.
- Baltic Dry index had a significant fall this week.
- Omicron outbreak in China disrupts Container Carriers significantly.

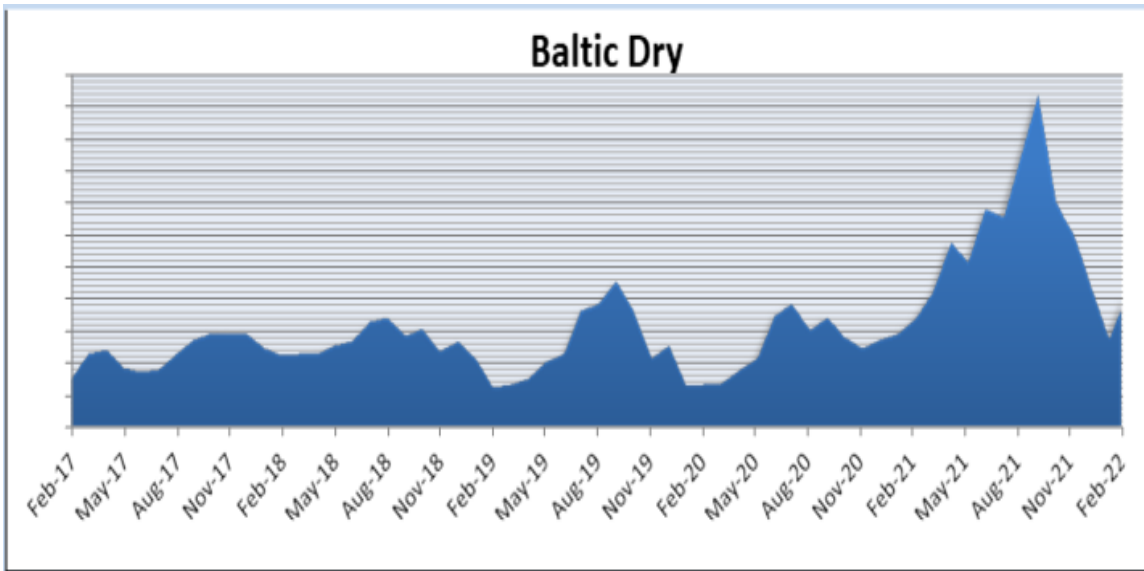
